In collaboration with its NGO partners, GR3 maximizes the manpower, resources, and experience of the world's best emergency care providers. Unlike NGOs who exit soon after a crisis, GR3 finishes the work of restoration with education in crisis prevention, skills training, and PFA trauma counseling for long-term resilience. Using train-the-trainer methods as a force multiplier of knowledge and skill, GR3's lasting footprint is an empowered host of local volunteers and certified professionals better prepared for the future.
- ✓ **Licensed, certified, and experienced disaster relief NGO** since 2002 with global reach across the USA, Europe, Asia & the Philippines, Central & South America, the Caribbean, Southeast Asia, and East Africa. With offices in the USA, Switzerland, and the Philippines, GR3 is a veteran of more than 105 crisis deployments across four continents that have generated over 350,000 trained volunteers and served more than 5 million meals. Some of the more recent include Katrina, the Philippines, Nepal, and Haiti.
